### **Tuition changes**

There are several changes that are occurring with the tuition amount this year. We are working at leveling out our lesson fees while trying to be very mindful of keeping costs down. We have not had a tuition increase for several years. Here is what you will see. As you can see in the current fee structure the cost as you increased your lesson time did not reflect the time spent

by our teachers. Our new fee structure should reflect that more accurately. We are also dropping the additional fee for multiple children within one family. We will now have just one family fee regardless of how many children participate.
